Treasurer Report to Date:

- GDOG board members have discussed what needs to be in the GDOG bylaws and Catherine Mahoney is in the process of typing up the rough draft. Once the final draft is complete, we will be filing our non-profit paperwork.
- Catherine Mahoney and Sarah Tyson have gotten a business credit card for GDOG to be used when needed to make online purchases for shirts, bandannas, etc.

- Santa pics should be available soon. Timarie Javier said she needed til after December 1st, 2012 to get the editing done and ready.
- Nancy Turner did have a conversation with Mayor Murphy about using an existing park for the dog park and he's still trying to push the Field of Dreams spot for the dog park. Existing parks don't have the water supply needed, are too small, and are usually located in neighborhoods.
- Catherine Mahoney spoke with her attorney friend that was going to help with the 501(c)3 status but will be talking to someone else instead that might work better for our purpose.
- Andrew McNeil had a list of fundraiser ideas that he shared with us: Pet Remembrance Tree-for remembrance of a lost loved pet to sell at \$5.00 per picture to put on the tree. Dog Shows is another idea, Golf Tournaments, Rent a puppy-set something up with the dog pound to rent a puppy for the day. Painting Paws-talk with the Shelter about painting pics with their own paws. Have competitions at the local schools to see who can collect the loosest change and have a reward for the winning school. Birthday pledge-ask friends and family members for donations to GDOG as their birthday gift. Pump it up-at gas stations pump gas for cars and wash windows for donations. Sale homemade dog treats.
- Jody McGee suggested doggie cakes for dog birthdays or special occasions. A Valentine's Day fundraiser could also be a great way to sell those cakes. Gayle Armer has a heart shaped baking pan. Jody mentioned that the Winter Western event out at the Cam-Plex is usually held in February around Valentine's Day. We can get a table setup to sell GDOG shirts and bandannas. Gayle will look into what it takes to make those cakes and boxes and if we need a permit to sell them. Gayle

will update Catherine Mahoney with the info she finds out.

- Catherine Mahoney mentioned we should try to hold another photo shoot. Bekah Taylor suggested Christmas in July.
- Samantha Montey mentioned having doggie boxes at different locations for donations for animals to help out the Animal Shelter to help get our name out there.
- Jody McGee also mentioned that we should contact Gillette Public Access channel to put our meetings on there. Samantha Montey will take care of this.
- We all agreed meetings shall be held on the 3rd Tuesday of each month. So far this date works for January, February, March 2013.
- Our next Dog Park Meeting will be Tuesday, January 15, 2013 at 7pm. Catherine Mahoney will get in touch with Kristy Fairfield to see if we can use the Lakeway Learning Center room.
